- Offers and provides telephonic and web-based cessation services for health plans and employer groups



NYSSQL Services

- Cessation coaching: up to 2 (two) coaching sessions and unlimited incoming calls
- Email or text support messages
- Nicotine Replacement Therapy
 - (phone and online registrations)
- Self-help materials
- QuitSite: <u>www.nysmokefree.com</u>
 - interactive and informational
- Refer or triage to other cessation services
 - (e.g., health plan, local or healthcare program, Asian Smokers Quitline)



NYSSQL NRT Availability*

- Eligibility criteria:
 18 years or older, NYS resident, no contraindications
 - Most are eligible!
- Can receive supply two (2) times in 12 months with 3-month interval
- 2- or 4-week supply available depending on resources (currently 4 weeks)
- Mailed out in 2-week shipments
- Moderate and heavy smokers receive a combination of nicotine patch and the gum or lozenge (combination therapy)

*Criteria subject to change per NYS BTC supply/discretion & NYC supply



Enhanced Services for ENDS Users

The New York State Smokers' Quitline's Response to Providing Enhanced Services for ENDS Users

Enhanced Services for ENDS Users



In response to the growing use of ENDS and the escalating reported health concerns, the NYS Department of Health moved swiftly to ensure the Quitline provided comparable services for ENDS users seeking help to quit nicotine use.

✓ As of October 29, 2019, the CDC reported 1,888 confirmed and probable lung injury cases associated with use of ENDS and 2 reported deaths in NYS.



✓ Although ENDS users make up a relatively small percent of those contacting the Quitline for help, the number of ENDS-only users contacting the Quitline has increased by 300% between September-October 2018 and September-October 2019.

 Members of the NYS DOH and Roswell Park worked in tandem to develop and implement NRT eligibility criteria and tailored coaching support for ENDS users seeking help from the Quitline.



Unleashing the Healing Power of Hope™



 Since these enhanced services are new, monitoring is in place to make adjustments based on emerging best practices.



 The Quitline is in the process of reviewing our Patient Referral Program to address referring ENDS users to the Quitline.



 Healthcare professionals, as an enhancement to onsite cessation interventions, are encouraged to refer ENDS



users to the Quitline using the same processes in place for referring traditional tobacco users.

What Are the Actual Services Provided to ENDS Users Who Contact the Quitline or Are Referred by Their Healthcare Professionals?



ENDS users seeking help are assessed for:

 All forms of tobacco use, including combustible and ENDS product use



- Time of use, frequency, and amount
- Level of motivation
- Readiness to quit



ENDS users of any age are eligible for coaching and support, comparable to traditional tobacco users:

- Offered two (2) coaching sessions with evidence-based approaches for treating nicotine dependence
- All tobacco users are advised to talk with their healthcare professional for support
- All insured tobacco users are advised to contact their health plan to access additional cessation benefits

ENDS users 18 years or older are screened to receive NRT comparable to traditional tobacco users:

- Up to 4 weeks of NRT for those who qualify (most qualify), 2 times/year
- Combination NRT
 (patch and gum/lozenge),
 provided as indicated



Anecdotal comments from ENDS users:

- ENDS users have quit smoking years ago.
- Believe because they get their vape products from a vendor, these are safe as opposed to products bought off the street.

Anecdotal comments from ENDS users:

 Report sneaking and using in places where smoking is banned.



 Most now think it is "ok" to vape or use ENDS in the house and around family (whereas they didn't with combustible cigarettes).

Additional Points:

- ✓ No reported complaints with NRT use thus far the behavior and wanting to sneak and smoke is still an issue with most.
- ✓ The contents of vaping products, including the level of nicotine, are not known.

Additional Points:

- ✓ Because the use of ENDS is relatively new compared to combustible products, a clear message about vaping and quitting is needed.
- ✓ We are still monitoring NRT use as part of our protocol.
- ✓ The message is still consistent that quitting tobacco-use is
 the best thing you can do for your health.

Key Points

Cessation coaching support is available for ENDS users contacting the Quitline.

NRT is available for those who qualify.

Healthcare professionals can refer their ENDS-using patients to the Quitline for additional support.

Monitoring and reviewing of best practices are ongoing to improve services for ENDS users.
